I. Abolish Nuclear Weapons by World Citizens

Introduction

Recently, I can feel a big wave of reassuring developments for world peace. The Mine Ban Treaty was concluded by the efforts of NGOs and the so-called “middle-power countries”. Then, the Cluster Bomb Ban Treaty was achieved through a similar process. In addition to the NGOs, the International Red Cross and the middle-power countries also participated in the Oslo Process.

We would like to apply the Hiroshima-Nagasaki Process. Non-nuclear countries and International NGOs will be the core to promote this process. We aim to establish an international treaty to ban the first use of nuclear weapons as well as use them as a threat. The ratification of this treaty and creation of international norms by many non-nuclear countries with the backing of international NGOs will lead to significant restriction of the use or threat of use of nuclear weapons.
